CSW's partnership with the West Hollywood-based June L. Mazer Lesbian Archives—the sole archival repository on the west coast dedicated to preserving lesbian and feminist history—to inventory, organize, preserve, and digitize several key Los Angeles-themed collections starts its second year in the Fall of 2008.
